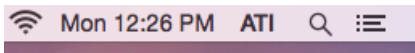


NaturalReader (MAC)

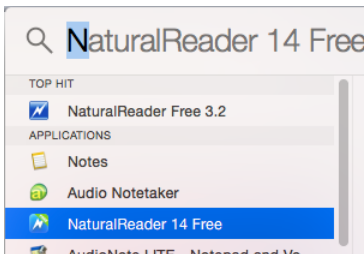
NaturalReader is a text to speech software utilized to listen to e-textbooks, PDF files, webpages, and other documents. Download the Windows version at <http://www.naturalreaders.com/download.html>.

Open NaturalReader

1. After downloading and installing NaturalReader, click on the **'Magnifying Glass'** in the top right corner.

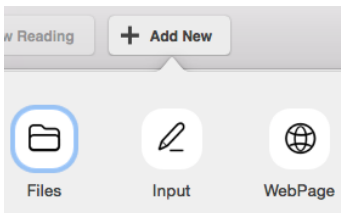


2. Type **'NaturalReader'** in the search box. Then, click on the **'NaturalReader Free'** icon.



Add a Document

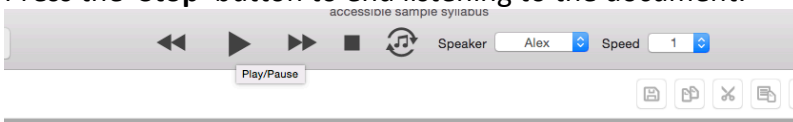
3. To add a document, click on the **'+ Add New'** button then select **'Files'** to browse for a file on the computer.



4. The document will open. Press the **'Back to Library'** button to return to the documents list and add additional files.

Listen to a Document

5. Click on a file in the document list.
6. Press the **'Play'** button to begin listening to the document.
7. Press the **'Stop'** button to end listening to the document.

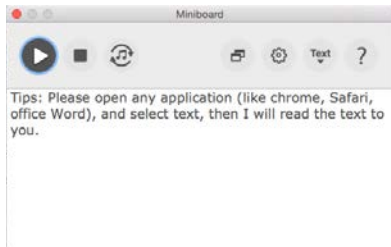
Listen to a Webpage

- To open a webpage select the **'WebPage'** icon and type in a web URL into the textbox. Press the **'Enter'** key.
- Click **'Listen Now'** then press the **'Play'** button to begin listening.
- Press the **'Stop'** button to end listening.



Miniboard

- Press the **'Miniboard'** button.
- Open any application (web browser or document) and select text.
- Press the **'Play'** button to begin listening to the selected text.
